

Labor and travel must be included in the warranty program. - Deliver, uncrate, set into place, make all the final connections and start-up of the instrument - Calibration certificate traceable to international standards. <p>Training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The training should cover lectures on the theory and principles of the instrument, its applications, software applications, data process, and interpretation, as well as intensive hands-on operation. Basic and advanced troubleshooting and maintenance including the verification of equipment's performance should also be discussed. The training shall be conducted on-site. <p>Documentation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Authenticated training certificate of Service Personnel from the manufacturer related to the installation, equipment maintenance, and troubleshooting. - 1 original copy and 1 photocopy of operating and service manuals in English. - Must provide the necessary information and test procedures required to prove that the instrument meets the specified requirements. - Test data and calibration certificates of the calibrating instruments used must be attached. 		<p>supplier states the system is installed and ready to perform in compliance with specifications.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If the system does not meet standard performance expectations, the Supplier will have one month to rectify the defects and clear the acceptance test, failing which, PSHS-ZRC reserves the right to get the equipment replaced by the Supplier at no extra cost to PSHS-ZRC. Succeeding conduct of the validation/qualification shall also be the responsibility and at the cost of the Supplier. <p>Other Requirements to include in the Philippine Bidding Document</p> <p>Section VI. Schedule of Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Power supply: 220 V - On warranty and after sales support, ALL delivered items should have one (1) year warranty on parts and labor - Bidder/Supplier should have authority to distribute the product by Original Manufacturing Company. - The bidder must submit the original brochure or actual image of ALL deliverables including specifications during bid submission. - If the supplied equipment is found defective and needs to be pulled-out, the contractor shall provide replacement with the same or higher specifications. - Render support services to PSHS-ZRC within the warranty period as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Technical support will be provided through phone calls or email within regular working hours from Monday to Friday, 8:00AM to 5:00PM b. If the supplied equipment is found defective and needs to be pulled-out, the contractor shall provide replacement with the same or higher specifications. c. Rectify and or/replace any part that fails to pass any test/inspection or make alteration necessary to meet the specification.
